The shiur, which lasts 30-45minutes, follows the order of Shulchan Aruch O.C. 451 and focuses on issues relating to issues relevant to food service and industrial kashrus. Examples of some of the topics already covered in the shiur include:

- Ceramic in industrial equipment-

 - Kli rishon which is off the fire
- Kashering plastic
- Kashering a homogenizer
- Three hag'alos for kli cheress
- Heat exchanger with regeneration
- Kashering between meat, dairy and pareve
